CALL FOR ARTISTS

The Art of Food 2009



Sunbury Shores is seeking artists interested in participating in 'The Art of Food,' a juried food - and drink - art exhibition to show from Oct. 9 to Nov. 4.

This exhibition is open to all artists and craftspeople residing in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and P.E.I. working in any medium such as painting, sculpture, printmaking, clay, wood, glass, metal,

textiles, etc. (Photography is excluded). Works must be inspired by food or drink.

Three monetary prizes will be awarded in the amounts of \$100, \$200 and \$300. In addition, there will be a digital camera awarded to the People's Choice Award winner.

Artist **Pablo Picasso** was born on October 25, 1881. He is one of the most recognized figures in 20th-century art. He is best known for co-founding the Cubist movement and for the wide variety of styles embodied in his work. Among his most famous works are the proto-Cubist *Les Femmes d'Alger* (O.J. No. 1) (1911) and *Guernica* (1937). Picasso died in 1973.

A SUNBURY HISTORY LESSON

Dorothy Meigs Eidlitz of Winter Park, Florida, was a long-time summer resident of St. Andrews. Her idea was to teach people to integrate studies of natural science and art as interdependent sources of inspiration and challenge. Mrs. Eidlitz believed in the Zen Buddhist concept of harmony between art and nature in the world around her and this belief became the basis for the Sunbury Shores **Arts & Nature** Centre.
